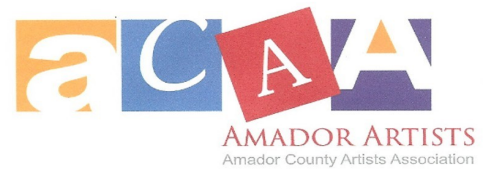

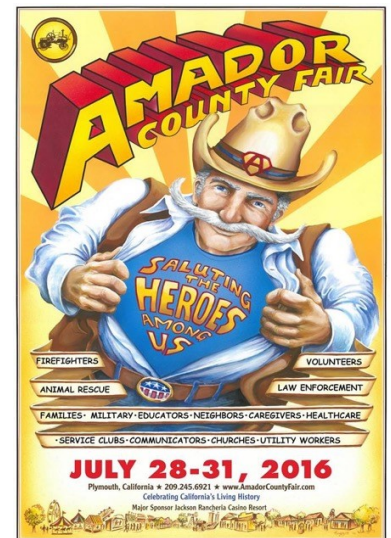

Entry forms need to be postmarked before Friday October 14th, 2016. There may be up to 4 entries per artist. Awards will include \$300 for Best of Show, \$100 for People's Choice, and monetary rewards for First, Second, and Third in each class. 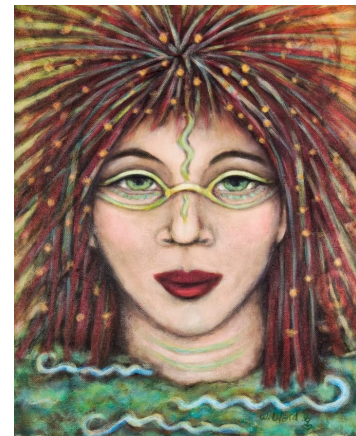
