The purpose of the Amador County Artists Association (ACAA) is to promote and encourage the production, cultivation and appreciation of art.

The Amador Artists' Open Studios Art Show is an event that does this for artists and attendees alike. It is also our primary fundraising event to raise money for the High School Student Art Show and for an annual scholarship that we give to a local high school student pursuing an art major in college.

ACAA manages the Fine Arts and Photography Department at the Amador County Fair in July, which gives adults and youth the chance to show their work publicly, and win ribbons and cash awards.

Members of ACAA are very active in art activities. Members mingle with other artists at monthly professional technique demonstrations and meetings. Our website, [www.amadorartists.org](http://www.amadorartists.org), the Facebook page (Amador County Artists Association) and newsletter publish art-related news, such as call to artist opportunities, and member events with samples of work.

Meetings are held at the Senior Center on New York Ranch Road in Jackson on the 2nd Wednesday of every month. You do not have to be a member to attend.

## Calling all Amador County Artists . . .

Open Studios Art Show on

In its 11th year, the ACAA provides this opportunity to showcase the work of local artists by offering the public a free exhibition of artists who live and work in Amador County.

Approximately 20 artists will have their work in the American Legion Hall for the week-end. In addition, we host a Fine Art Raffle that supports the ACAA's fundraising efforts for student art awards and scholarships.

The ACAA heavily publicizes the Open Studios Art Show with posters and signs, announcements in magazines, newspapers and online.

Artists are assigned space on a first-come, first-served basis and are expected to participate in the set up and take down of the location. Spaces are 8'x8' and may be shared. There will be a food vendor on site during the event.

**Deadline to sign up: June 8, 2018**  
**You need to submit your registration,  
photo, and pay your fees by this date.**  
**No exceptions**

**Earlier sign-ups are necessary if you want  
us to help with photography.**

### To participate

Fill out and submit the enclosed registration form and appropriate fees (see form). The art is not juried, but we do expect professional-level work from all participants. The fee and any monies you choose to spend in preparation and promotion are your only costs; all income from sales is your own. Artists are welcome to join the Amador Artists Open Studios group on Facebook to stay abreast of pertinent information and tips for a better experience.

### Your responsibilities are:

Email a .jpg photo of your work for use in publicity. Suggested min. 300 dpi. Printed poster photo will be approximately 1.5" x 1.5". We can help with photos. (Check box on application)

Provide contact information for use in publicity and the poster.

Help with some necessary job that fits your talents and time.

Publicize the event to your email list/patrons.

Donate a piece of **original art** (no prints or giclees-photos being the exception) to the Artists' Raffle, our scholarship fundraiser. **Art work must be wired to hang or ready for display.**

Set up your own display space.

Handle your own sales, collections and tax obligations.

Help with set up and tear down of the event.

Provide after-show feedback to improve future events.

### Entry Fees:

ACAA members: \$50 per artist

Non-members: \$65 per artist

Make checks payable to ACAA.

### Fees Cover:

Hall space rental

Printing of posters

Publicity—posters, artist newsletters,  
calendar listings and newspapers
