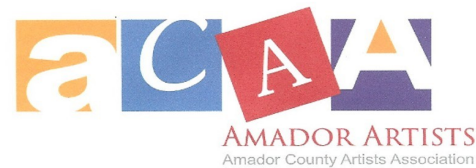

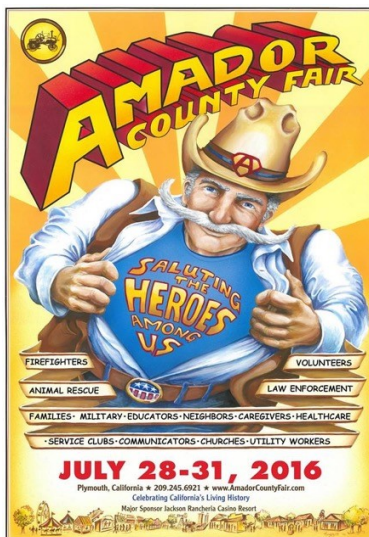

This year's event on Sept. 17th and 18th promises to be even bigger than previous years with the addition of a preview show at AmadorArts Gallery and raffle prizes on display at various locations in the weeks prior to the event. The raffle is the main fundraiser for the High School Student Art Show and the Annual Scholarship Award. Planning meetings are held at 6pm prior to the general meeting and your participation is needed to make this a successful event!

## Karen Crane to Demonstrate Wire Wrapping on June 8th

Wire jewelry artist Karen Crane will demonstrate free-form, wire-wrap techniques at the June 8 meeting of the Amador County Artists Association. Crane starts projects with some basic, simple techniques and will demonstrate several as she creates a hanging project. She uses techniques that she has developed over the past 15 years. These techniques can be the basis of pendants and earrings, but they are also used to wrap stones, shells and beach glass to make room and porch hangers. Many examples of different applications of these techniques will be available for study and inspiration. As she works, Crane will talk about how to select appropriate materials, what kinds of wire to use and how to solve creative challenges.

Karen teaches wire-wrap classes locally and sells her work at the AmadorArts Gallery in Sutter Creek and on Facebook.
