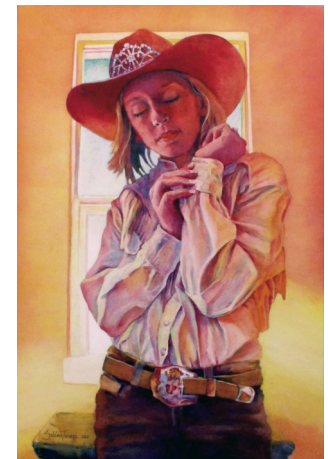
Jeweled Warrior

Art runs in Sabina's family. The great-granddaughter of a noted German sculptor who created the "Bremen Horsemen"; daughter of a ballerina mother, and of a father who was responsible for the sets on the original "Star Trek" TV series and built the Enterprise stage set. Sabina was drawn to art as a child, at the age of eight she began studying at the Art Institute of Chicago. After moving to California, she took classes with Guy Diehl and Jack Ward at Chabot College, Jade Fon at Diablo Valley College, and was able to study with other notable artists associated with the "California School of Watercolor" such as Gerald Brommer, Mario Cooper, Dong Kingman and Millard Sheets. More recently she has studied oil painting with Jeffery Watts, and attended American Artist's "Weekend With The Masters". Her greatest mentor, however, was Juan Pena with whom she spent many years studying classical portrait from live models.



The Next Stop

After working as a graphic artist with Pacific Bell, Sabina decided to pursue her fine art career full time. Her work has been shown on TV, in magazines and books, included in solo shows and many group exhibits where she has taken numerous "Best of Show" awards. Most recent juried shows include the 2012 Oil Painters of America National Exhibit; the 2010 National Watercolor Society's 90th Anniversary Exhibit; the 2011 National Watercolor Society's Traveling Exhibition; the 2010 Red River Watercolor Society National Exhibit where she received the Winsor Newton Award from Juror Judi Betts; the 2009 Watercolor West International Exhibit and the Pittsburgh Watercolor Society's 2010 Aqueous Open. Sabina is a popular Juror and Demonstrator for Art Associations and shares her knowledge through classes and workshops.
